



Tapestry with the Wedding of Emperor Luis XIV

(in honor of Cardinal Cupich)

Total Cost: \$266,000



Artist: Le Gobleins after Charles Le Brun

Materials: Silk, wool, and gold thread

Pledged in April 2016, this is the Patrons' current restoration project being restored in honor of Cardinal Cupich. Once the restoration is completed, the Patrons will be working with the Vatican to bring the tapestry to Chicago for exhibition. *Funds committed to date:* \$178,125; funds needed: \$87,875.00.

Associates Restoration Project - Update



The Associate Patrons fundraising efforts for their second project, Thirteen figurative Attic vases from the Astarita Room, began in 2017 during their March 8th, Annual Spring Social. The cost of the restoration is \$16,325.00.

Funds raised to date total \$11,799. These funds have been raised from the 2017 Annual Spring Social, Silent Auction during the Patrons' Art & Faith Lecture Series in July, the Londo Mondo shopping event, the 2018 Annual Spring Social and individual donations.
